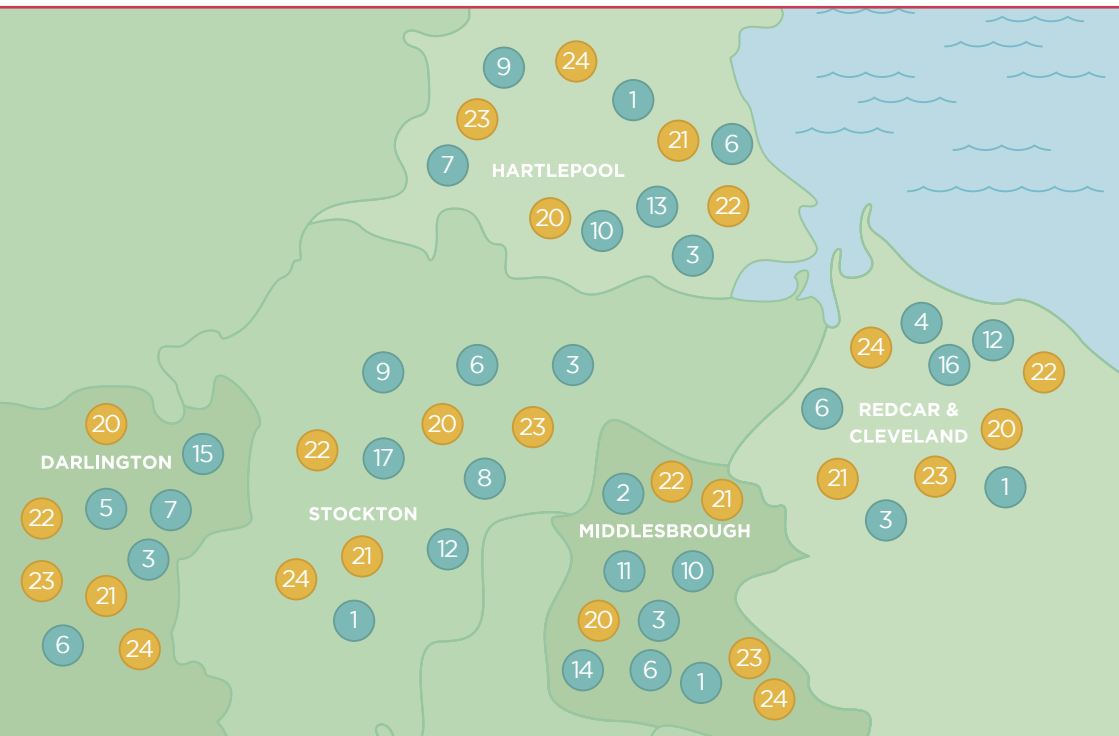
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What are the Tees Valley Pathways & Routeways Programmes?

The Tees Valley Pathways and Routeways Programmes are part-funded by the European Social Fund and are supported under the Youth Employment Initiative delivering until 31st December 2023.

The aim of the provision is to support unemployed and/or economically inactive young people aged 15 to 29 across Tees Valley.

We can support you to overcome any barriers and achieve your career ambitions by progressing into a positive destination such as Apprenticeships or Employment. The programmes are delivered by our partnership incorporating 18 organisations who operate across the whole of the Tees Valley.

- **Tees Valley Pathways:** Offers personalised education, employment and enterprise opportunities alongside innovative activities with bespoke support and enrichment activities such as sport, digital and creative media.
- **Tees Valley Routeways:** Offers guaranteed interviews for employment and learning opportunities in partnership with employers. The programme is linked to growth sectors such as Advanced Manufacturing, Digital and Logistics.

Since the programmes commenced more than 10,000 young people across Tees Valley have accessed our bespoke and innovative support. This has resulted in more than 5,000 young people progressing into Education, Employment, Self-Employment or Further Training.

Ben moved into the area to live with his mother after suffering with depression and other difficulties. He wanted to work, but lacked the confidence to enable him to secure or hold down a job so joined the Tees Valley Pathways Programme with The Junction Foundation.

He outlined his work experience to his YEI Adviser. With the support of his Adviser, Ben researched the skills and knowledge required for a variety of sectors including warehousing, care and construction which highlighted that Ben would benefit from completing a Warehousing & Logistics and Health & Safety in the Workplace Programmes.

Ben sent out his updated CV and applied for a number of jobs and following an application to work as a Cleaning Operative at James Cook Hospital he was invited to an interview. Ben was supported with interview skills and was provided with interview clothes and transport costs to enable him to attend the interview via the programmes Flexible Fund.

He was successful at interview and was offered a position and is now proud to be one of the key workers in James Cook Hospital and has provided a lot of help and support during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

Through intensive, individually designed mentoring we work with you to enhance your employability with CV development, interview skills and job applications to further your individual growth.

Support is also offered to improve interpersonal skills including teamwork, communication and motivation through fun and engaging activities, helping you gain the confidence needed and bringing you a step closer towards your chosen career path. As with Routeways our Pathways programme can also provide financial support where required.



Clair self-referred herself to ITEC North East's Tees Valley Pathways Programme during the lockdown period as she had been unemployed for more than a year.

She met virtually with her YEI Adviser and after discussing a variety of career options Clair identified she was interested in securing employment in Customer Service or Manufacturing. With support from her Adviser, Clair's CV was updated to ensure it was fit for purpose and regular job search sessions were carried out in her preferred sectors and she was supported to apply for a number of positions. Following an application, she was invited to a virtual interview for a position with Amazon.

As Clair was unsure what this would entail she was provided with interview skills support and her Adviser carried out a mock interview to help her to be more confident for her interview with Amazon. Clair was provided with work clothes and travel via the YEI Flexible Fund.

Clair attended the virtual interview and secured a position where she is currently employed and enjoying her role in Distribution.

Anna came to the United Kingdom from Ukraine eight years ago and was unemployed so attended a Youth Obligation event hosted by Hartlepool Jobcentre Plus. After a brief discussion with one of the YEI Advisers from Hartlepool Borough Council, Anna decided she wanted to find out more about how the Tees Valley Pathways Programme could help her to secure employment.

She attended an initial meeting with her YEI Adviser which helped to establish her goals and identify the barriers and the support she required. Anna had a Bachelor's Degree in Criminology with Psychology and had previously worked as a Care Assistant.

She was interested in working within the Justice System but she was unsure what roles were available and what she would be qualified to apply for and therefore needed support from the YEI Programme.

Anna was supported to explore the different roles available and identify where her skills and interests would match. She felt her best route would be to enter into a job as an Administrator and learn about the Sector.

Together with her Adviser, Anna reviewed her CV and amendments were made to highlight her skills and experience. She was supported with guidance to compile covering letters for job applications including those through Online Platforms.

During the lockdown period Anna kept in regular contact with her Adviser and was persistent with her job search and she has now been successful in securing full time employment with the NHS as a Clerical Officer.

Anna is enjoying her new role and said 'Tees Valley Pathways supported me in times when I thought nothing was working the way I wanted. My Adviser helped me to remain positive and it was an uplifting experience'.

Middlesbrough
moving forward



Jade was referred to Middlesbrough Council's Choosing Pathways programme by her JCP Work Coach.

She met with her Learning Adviser to discuss the support that could be offered via YEI and was initially reluctant to discuss her past, however she became open about her situation and how she felt.

Jade was supported by her Learning Adviser to identify areas of development to help her to gain employment. The first step was to address her Mental Health and with her Adviser they sought support from various local organisations and agreed the most appropriate organisation was MIND. She engaged with MIND and with the support of her Learning Adviser she reviewed her CV, developed her confidence and improved her self-marketing skills.

She met with her Adviser on a weekly basis and built up a strong rapport. Jade attended interview preparation sessions which allowed her to structure responses to interview questions and how to deal with anxiety on the day.

Jade accessed work experience with Three13 Training in Business Administration which gave her the confidence to move forward. Using the skills and knowledge she had built up she updated her CV so that it was relevant for each post she applied for.

Jade was successful in securing a full time position as a Business Administrator with a supermarket, based in Stockton.

She has been in post for more than 4 months, she said "I am so proud of what I have done; I have made new friends along the way. I am now working in a role which I really enjoy and hope it will help me to develop further."

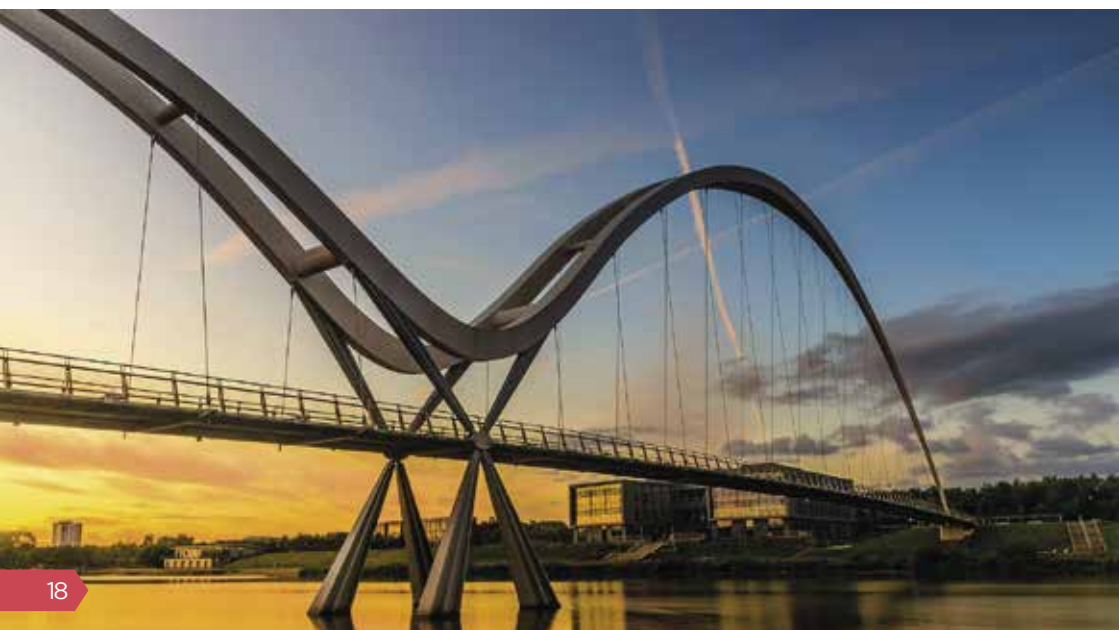
