# Entry & Level 1 Courses Free for those aged 19+ who are either unemployed or meet the Low Wage Criteria.\* Level 2 Courses Free if you are: 19-23 and have not previously achieved a full Level 2, or; 19+ studying an eligible Distance Learning Course 19+ and are either unemployed or meet the Low Wage Criteria.\* Free Courses for Jobs

This is designed to help adults aged 19+ to gain the valuable skills needed to improve their job prospects. You can access a free Level 3 qualification if you have not previously completed a full Level 3, if you are unemployed or if you meet the Low Wage Criteria.\*

#### ►Level 3 Courses

#### Free if you are:

19+ and have not previously
achieved a full Level 3;
19+ and meet criteria for Free
Courses for Jobs or Career
Change.

#### ►Advanced Learner Loan

These are available for those aged 19+ to undertake Level 3 to Level 6 qualifications. If the course is not free then this provides you with financial support and you only need to repay when your income is over a certain threshold.
